RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- 1.—That the Annual Subscription be One Pound.
- 2.—That the day of Meeting be on Thursday, during the Months of May, June, July, August and September, and the time three o'clock.
- 3.—That every Member not appearing by four o'clock, pay a fine of One Shilling.
- 4.—That Honorary Members, admitted as such, be exempted from Fines for non-attendance.
- 5.—That Members during residence at either of the Universities, be exempted from Fines for non-attendance.
- 6.—That Members residing at more than five miles distance from Tonbridge, be exempted from Fines for non-attendance.
- 7.—That any person wishing to become a Member, be proposed and seconded by two Members, and balloted for on the following day of Meeting, not less than five Members being present.
- 8.—That the Annual Subscription of One Pound, be paid by every Member on his election.
- 9.—That Members failing to pay their Annual Subscription, on or before the first day of Meeting, in the month of June be Fined Five Shillings.
- 10.—That every Member be at liberty to introduce a friend on the days of Meeting, but such friend not to be introduced more than once in any one month.
- 11.—That the affairs of the Club be conducted by the President, Vice-President, Secretary, and five other Members to be chosen, together with a Treasurer, annually on the first day of Meeting; the President, Vice-President, Secretary, and such five Members, forming a Committee, any three of whom (including the President, Vice-President, or Secretary,) shall form a quorum.
- 12.—That the Committee transact the routine and detail of business generally, receive propositions for the admission of new Members, and report monthly their proceedings, and the state of the finances of the Club to the General Meetings, for their confirmation and approval.
- 13.—That a General Meeting of the Members take place after the play, on the first Thursday in the months of May, June, July, August and September, to transact any business which may present itself, and to receive the report and confirm the proceedings of the Committee.
- 14.—That any Member wishing to withdraw from the Club, give notice thereof to the Secretary, on or before the first day of May, or be required to pay his Subscription for that year.
- 15.—That notice be given one week previously to the discussion of any motion affecting the Rules.
- 16.—That a copy of these Rules be transmitted to each Member of the Club.
